RE: Pilot Program: Quikclot Combat Gauze

April 1st, 2020 each of AMR Contra Costa County Ambulances will have two (2) Quikclot Combat Gauze packages on each ambulance. One Quikclot Combat gauze will be placed in the trauma section of the medical bag, and the other within the trauma dressing cabinet.

Quikclot combat gauze will be used in adherence to Contra Costa County Emergency Medical Services Treatment Guideline section T04 Extremity Trauma, T05 Head Trauma, and T06 Multisystem Trauma.



“Hemostatic gauze is primarily indicated for: Uncontrolled hemorrhage when tourniquets cannot be used.”
