Re: Glucagon Product Change

Due to a back order of the current Glucagon prefilled syringes, you should soon expect to see on the ambulance single dose vials that we have used in the past. If you are not familiar with this particular product it is nearly identical in its preparation and administration, with the exception of having to draw up the sterile water in a syringe before mixing it with the powder. The reconstituted solution should be clear and of water-like consistency.



To be clear, there is nothing wrong with the current prefilled syringe kits that are currently on the ambulance, and you should continue to use them as stock remains.
